The Obama administration announced today that it will accelerate approvals on 7 transmission line projects, including the Susquehanna-Roseland project. It touts “job creation”, without a mention of all of the negative impacts this particular project would have on our landscape and on property values.

A total of 10 Governors in the Northeast are in favor of the offshore wind project that is in the works off the east coast – see attached. The Susquehanna-Roseland line would carry coal fired energy from VA, WV and PA to our area, and has nothing to do with “clean energy”.

This does not relieve PSE&G of their requirements to meet NJ DEP permitting requirements, and the National Park Service’s Environmental Impact Statement guidelines must still be followed.

Corporate profit should not be given priority here. Fast-tracking the destruction of a priceless national treasure – the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area - must not be allowed.
